Our team uses a range of resources including games, Interactive Whiteboard, iPad, CD Roms etc. The intervention approaches applied are informed by the latest evidence in the research literature. The underlying skills essential for literacy success are addressed and reinforced including sound letter knowledge, phonological awareness and auditory discrimination. Single word reading, single word spelling, text reading and text writing are also addressed using a variety of motivational resources.

- Individualized goals based on assessment results;
- Individual sessions with an experienced Speech Pathologist;
- Each student receives their own Literacy Pack;
- A variety of motivational resources are used;
